Minutes

The regular monthly meeting was called to order by Pres. Bill Hurtenbach at 7:38p.m., located in the meeting room of the State Bank of the Lakes of Grayslake.

The secretary had no report.

Treasurer Hull reported checking account balance of \$1267.76, but was unable to report the balance in the Scudder account, since he hadn't received the report as yet. He did state that he transferred \$2000 from that account in order to pay current bills including \$291 to Kim Spath for Polaroid film and postage; \$199 to purchase a public address speaker system; \$62.55 to Doris Gaddis for runway center line paint and eating utensils; \$50 for desert prizes; \$97.19 to Sue Hurtenbach for fly-in supplies; \$620 for web site.

Some commentary ensued regarding the cost of the website, largely that it seemed like a lot. Conjecture was that it was in part because we had two sites: org and. com. It was generally felt that two were unnecessary, if that was the cause of the high cost, but since the webmaster was not in attendance, the matter was deferred.

Treasurer Hull also stated that he received information from Oshkosh about the 2004 calendars. After a brief discussion, Bill Butler made a motion that we forego selling them this year, especially since it is so late in the season. Seconded by Doris Gaddis. Motion passed unanimously.

53 young eagles were flown on Sept 20. Next flight is October 18. Estimate was that the chapter surpassed its record of last year.

Membership chairman Johnson reported that we have 44 active members, and handed out a list of them.

Technical Counselors Gaddis reported visiting McEver and Paulsen who are building a Lancair Super ES. Their work is very good.

Nominating committee Chairman Butler reported that he is striving for two nominees per position. To date he has for President: Bill Hurtenbach and Jim Hull; for vice president Sue Hurtenbach and Jeff Barnes; for secretary John Gaddis; for treasurer Doris Gaddis and Bill Parmer. A ballot will be in the November SHORELINES.

Vice Pres. Hurtenbach is seeking ideas and ways to generate interest in our Chapter. One thing she thought beneficial would be a brochure of our activities and interests. Help is needed to create and produce it. One other idea that ensued from the discussion of this subject was to sponsor seminars of interest to pilots, especially safety seminars. These could possibly be the topic of our monthly meetings.

At 8:50 Pres. Hurtenbach called a recess after which a video tape sanctioned by the TSA, AOPA and FAA was shown regarding each pilot's responsibility in safeguarding our airports.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30.
